The lesson




- 40 minutes.
- 15 students, 8 girls and 7 boys.
- Devices needed
 - Ipads with the quizlet app and an internet connection.





Preparation

- Sign up for an account on quizlet.com.
- Make a study set to train in that lesson.
- Copy the link and put it onto Google Classroom for your students.





Introduction


- Students work on their own at first but later on in pairs.
- Students learn some proverbs and phrases.
- Students go to Google
 Classroom and find the link.





Implementation

- 10 minutes with flashcards.
 - Swipe right if they know the answer .
 - Swipe left if they have to study it better.
- 10 minutes learn and match.
- 10 minutes Quizlet live in teams.





Conclusion

- The teacher can see which pairs are the first to finish.
- One incorrect answer everything starts from the
 beginning and the group
 loses time.
- Next lesson
 - More work with these proverbs and phrases in a writing assignment.
